ECONOSPACEMAKING [1 or 2-day]

This is an ideal way for someone who wants an EconoSpace to get components made! Buildings costing between 5,000- 10,000 will be featured. Design and construction information on this type of building will be available at all Tour events.

DREAM HOME WORKSHOP

Discovering the ways in which our homes can be shaped to accommodate change in our lives is the promise of this 1-day workshop. Participants will be encouraged to think of their homes in fresh and exciting ways. Amongst other things, they will receive instruction on how to survey their properties and prepare scale drawings and models of them. Apart from examining the physical impact our homes can have on us, the workshop will also explore the impact on a buildings' occupants of its 'invisible architecture'. Invisible Architecture covers all the unseen but nonetheless potent aspects of a building's 'life'. Does the building make one happy? Does it assist one in realising ones dreams? Is it a creative place? Does it foster positive feelings? Does it make one feel energised and empowered to initiate change?
